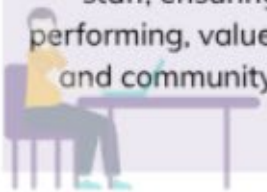
Campus Support Team

Culture

Academic Excellence

What can parents do to help their child/ren?

1. Use marks and feedback to engage your child/ren in conversations.
 - ✓ Read Semester 1 Reports
 - ✓ **Access your child/ren's individual Canvas courses** to understand:
 - Marks/Feedback for individual tasks
 - Missing Submissions/Late Submissions to help them manage their time
2. Make sure your child/ren in 7-12 come to school each Monday with a **Study plan**.
3. **Sign up for Parent Interviews**. Be prepared with knowledge of how your child is performing so you can ask questions and seek clarification.
4. **Read the MAP reports** when they come and reach out to classroom teachers, homeroom teachers, Mrs. Polster, or Mrs. Taylor if you need help.

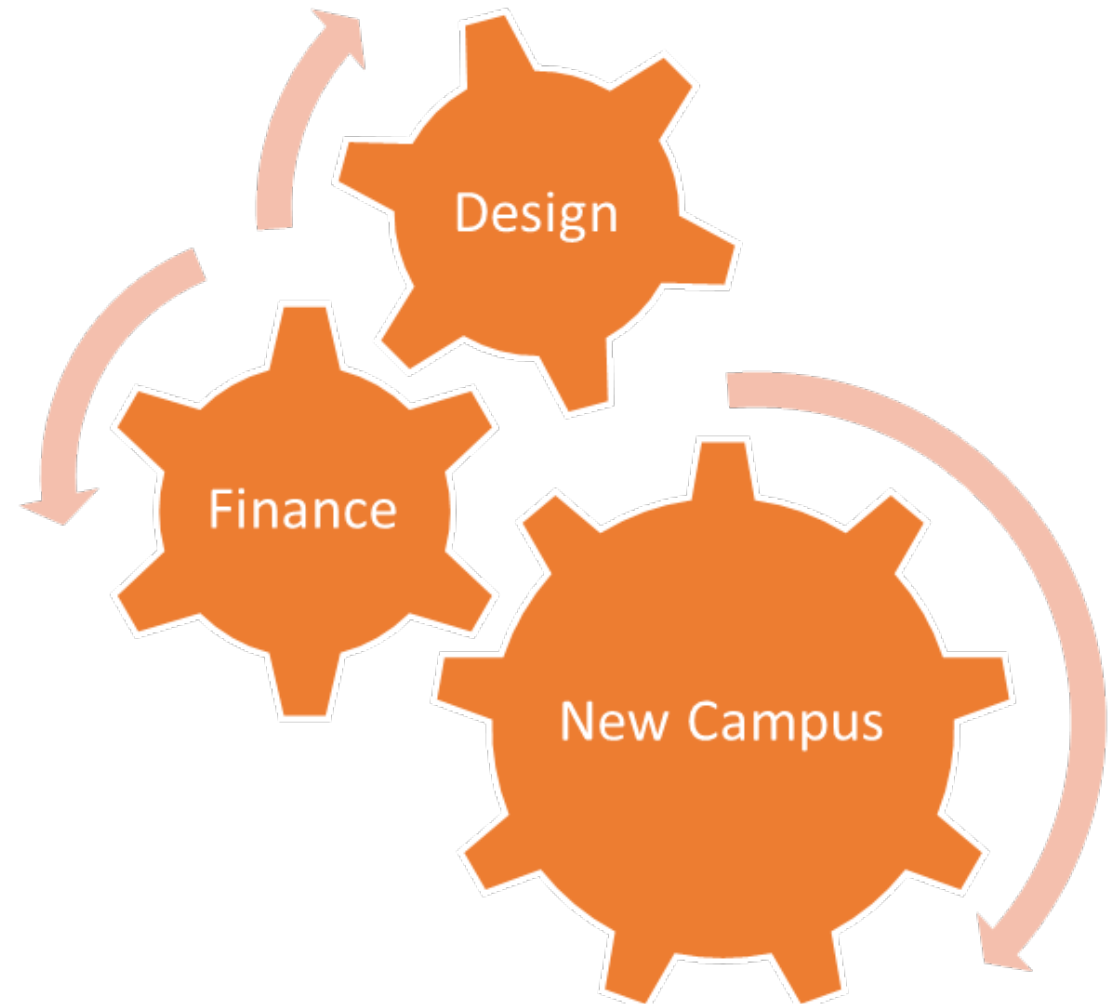
