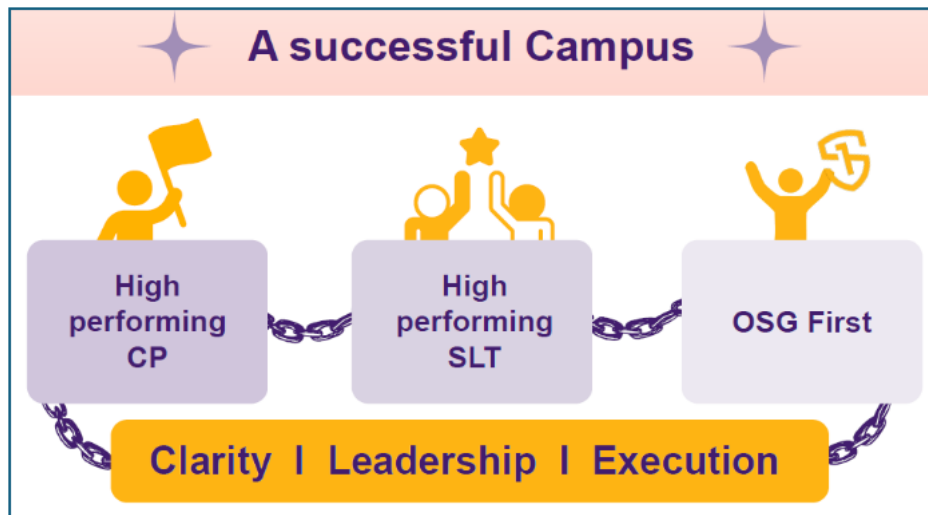


SLT 2027:

In 2027, the SLT structure is changing globally with the introduction of a team of 4 students per campus.

Why OSG is moving to a max. 4 x Student Leadership Team (SLT) Model



At OneSchool Global, student leadership is about **impact and influence**, not simply holding a title.

Following extensive consultation with campuses globally, we are moving to a maximum of **four Student Leaders per campus** to create a "**smaller team with a wider reach.**"

The **goal is to strengthen student leadership** by increasing accountability, influence, and measurable outcomes, while ensuring more students have opportunities to contribute to campus life.

This change is not about reducing leadership opportunities. Instead, it is about ensuring SLT members have clear responsibilities, lead meaningful projects, and use their influence to make a positive difference in learning, wellbeing, and campus culture. Success will be measured by the impact student leaders have on their campus, not simply by participation or the number of events they organise.

Importantly, leadership will be distributed more broadly. SLTs will work closely with Student Councils, Class Representatives and Homeroom Representatives, giving more students a voice and creating more leadership opportunities across the school. Student leaders will act as facilitators and project managers, empowering others to contribute, lead initiatives and drive positive change.

The new approach focuses on building leadership capability, strengthening student voice, improving learning behaviours, and creating sustained cultural improvement. Student leaders will be expected to demonstrate clear evidence of their influence on learning, wellbeing, engagement and campus culture.

Ultimately, this change supports our commitment to developing **Life Ready students** who can lead with purpose, influence others positively, manage projects effectively, and create meaningful outcomes for their peers and school community.

The message is simple: Fewer titles. Greater impact. Stronger influence. Wider student voice. More leadership opportunities for all.

APPLICATIONS AND SELECTION OF SLT
