



Student Uniform & Dress Code Policy

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1. POLICY STATEMENT

OneSchool Global (OSG) acknowledges the positive role of a school uniform and dress code in promoting a sense of pride and unity among students. Wearing a school uniform enhances identification with the school, supports equity, and contributes to a safe and respectful learning environment.

This policy forms part of OSG's global operational framework and ensures alignment with OSG's standards of safety, equity, and consistency across all campuses.

2. PURPOSE

To ensure that all OSG students maintain a high standard of dress and appearance consistent with the ethos and standards of OneSchool Global. Students are expected to wear the OSG OneLook uniform collection correctly and with respect.

3. SCOPE

This policy applies to all students across OneSchool Global campuses worldwide.

All prospective students and parents/guardians are notified of uniform requirements prior to enrolment and receive a copy of this policy.

The OSG OneLook uniform collection is available through the online store (<https://uniform.oneschoolglobal.com>) with delivery to parents' homes.

4. IMPLEMENTATION

4.1 Rollout

The OSG OneLook uniform collection provides a complete package of approved garments. It is mandatory from:

4.1.1 Southern Hemisphere: first day of academic year 2026 (typically February)

4.1.2 Northern Hemisphere: first day of academic year 2026/27 (typically August–September)

4.1.3 Mixing old and new uniform items is not permitted beyond these implementation dates.

4.2 Transition period

Until the final day of academic year 2025 (Southern Hemisphere) and academic year 2025/26 (Northern Hemisphere), students must wear the full legacy uniform. After these dates, only the OSG OneLook uniform collection may be worn.

4.3 Relocation

If a student relocates between hemispheres, they must comply with the uniform regulations of their new campus location.

4.4 General expectations

Students must wear full school uniform on all school days, including while travelling to and from school and during excursions, unless otherwise authorised. Parents must provide a note of explanation if the correct uniform cannot be worn (e.g., for medical or exceptional reasons).

4.5 Sports uniform

The OSG OneLook uniform sports collection must be worn only on days when physical education or sport is timetabled. Students are not permitted to wear sports uniforms outside of these times, except for the softshell jacket or junior soft jacket, which may be worn with the academic uniform.

5. DRESS CODE STANDARDS

5.1 Skirt/dress length

Skirts and dresses must be at least knee length. Exception: Sports skirts must reach the knee unless worn with leggings or bike shorts.

5.2 Jewellery

Jewellery is not permitted, except for:

- A medical alert bracelet
- A plain wristwatch (smartwatches are not permitted as per the Student ICT Policy)

5.3 Hair

Hair must be clean, neat, and kept off the face.

Appropriate hair accessories for school uniform include OSG branded products, which can be purchased from the OSG online uniform store. Students may also wear simple hair ties/elastics and clips in navy or black. Feathers, flowers, and other large items are not considered suitable for the school uniform and should not be worn.

5.4 Make-up

Make-up should be minimal and discreet. Obvious eye make-up, eyebrow paint, and coloured lipstick are not permitted. Permissible items include:

- Spot concealer or cover-up
- Clear lip balm
- Clear nail polish

5.5 Body marking

Students must not write on or allow others to write on their bodies or uniforms.

5.6 Footwear

Shoes must be regular black leather or leather-look school shoes. Suede shoes, boots, or leisure shoes are not acceptable, except in extreme cold or snow where black low-heeled boots may be worn.

Joggers are permitted only for sports activities.

5.7 Accessories

- Neck scarves: Only those in the approved OSG range may be worn.
- Ties: Optional for day-to-day activities for Years 7–13. May be required at formal events and specified excursions.
- Belts: Only OSG-approved belts are permitted.

5.7.1 Hats: In Southern Hemisphere regions, a SunSmart-compliant hat must be worn outdoors during Terms 1 and 4 (or as required by regional regulations). Bucket hats are compliant; caps and visors are optional but not SunSmart and may not be worn during those terms. While not mandatory, Northern Hemisphere regions should follow similar process to protect students from sun.

5.8 House shirts

House shirts may be worn only during official house events such as athletics, competitions, or house sports days.

5.9 School bags

Students may use OSG-branded school bags from either the OneLook or previous catalogue. Non-OSG or designer-branded bags are not permitted.

5.10 Winter coats

Where additional warmth is required, students may wear outerwear from the OneSchool OneLook collection. If conditions require alternative garments, these must be dark in color, plain, and without non-OSG logos (small discreet branding permitted).

6. LEAVERS JACKETS

Final-year students may purchase an approved OSG leavers jacket from the online uniform store as a commemorative privilege.

Terms of use:

- 6.1 Only first names or surnames are permitted and are subject to approval before production.
- 6.2 The interior may include a list of graduates for that hemisphere.
- 6.3 Jackets may not be worn at public events, graduation ceremonies, or other formal events. Blazers are to be worn at all public, graduation or other formal events.
- 6.4 Purchase is optional and self-funded. No student should feel pressured to buy one.



7. GARMENT CARE

Uniforms must be kept clean, tidy, and presentable. Damaged items that cannot be repaired must be replaced promptly. All items should be clearly labelled with the student's name

8. COMPLIANCE

Non-compliance with this policy may result in disciplinary action in accordance with campus-level student conduct procedures. Parents and guardians are expected to support the school in maintaining these standards.

9. DEFINITIONS

Term	Definition
OneSchool OneLook uniform collection	The range that has been collated and catalogued from which the parents can order the students' uniform requirements. This range can be purchased via the online store (https://uniform.oneschoolglobal.com).
Dress code	Standards relating to the overall appearance of students.
SunSmart Hat	Broad-brimmed hat compliant with regional SunSmart guidelines.
