Dear Parents,

It is now more than a full term since we launched the OneSchool One Look school uniform, and we would like to remind families of the importance of students wearing it with care, respect, and a strong sense of responsibility.

When a student wears the OneSchool Global uniform, they carry more than a school badge – they carry the reputation of our entire OneSchool global community. Every interaction, in and out of school hours, shapes how our students are seen and how OneSchool Global is recognised.

The uniform should always be worn in full and correctly, and each student plays an important role in protecting and strengthening the school's positive reputation and demonstrating personal maturity and character.

About our new uniform

The new uniform is designed as a 'collection' - meaning there is no longer a summer or winter range - and students can mix and match items such as long versus short sleeve shirts, giving students flexibility day to day. If you are unsure of what items can and cannot be worn, please refer to the Lookbook on the uniform website.

However, whilst the range gives flexibility, OSG still expects that your child(ren) wear the uniform correctly and in full, in accordance with all OSG uniform policy. This covers appropriate footwear, correct layering, and maintaining the uniform in a neat and presentable condition each day.

A reminder that:

- Shirts must be neatly tucked in and presentable.
- Boys must wear the correct school trousers, trousers outside of the range are not permitted. Please note a slim line trouser is being introduced based on valued parent and student feedback – further information will be shared when these are available for purchase on the online uniform store.
- Students should wear their blazers rather than the Year 12 leavers jacket for formal dress days (e.g. photos day, or when special visitors are expected) and for excursions.
- While ties are not compulsory, they are strongly encouraged for daily wear.
- Our enhanced accessory range has been designed specifically for students, so the correct accessories must be worn at all times – this includes belts, hats, socks, and hair accessories.
- Footwear and any additional layers must comply with the uniform policy.
- Hoodies should only be worn on Sports Days.

To support students in meeting these expectations, Campus Principals will be actively monitoring and insisting correct uniform requirements. They may request students to make adjustments to ensure they are aligned with OSG guidelines, and we ask that this be respected.

Wearing the uniform properly reflects respect for the school, shows consideration for fellow students, and maintains a positive standard of personal presentation.
